





Options For Illinois Tollway Customers

I-PASS customers pay via existing accounts

- Must have an I-PASS in every car
- 50 percent discount for cars
- 33 percent discount for trucks

Obtain an I-PASS

Unpaid toll payments


7 days to pay online

Fines for unpaid tolls

- \$10 per violation at time of notice
- \$25 per escalated violation






Using Your I-PASS on Other Toll Roads

I-PASS can be used anywhere E-ZPass is accepted

Accepted in 16 states by 37 toll agencies





Jurisdictional Transfer

Illinois Route 390 Proposed Right-of-Way

Tollway/IDOT to acquire all right-of-way

After all right-of-way is acquired and construction is complete, Tollway will transfer right-of-way not required for Tollway maintenance/jurisdiction to others via intergovernmental agreement


Tollway to retain right-of-way required for Illinois Route 390 mainline, ramps and associated appurtenance (i.e. detention basins and compensatory storage)

Illinois Route 390 Land Transfer - IDOT

IDOT transferred Elgin O'Hare Expressway right-of-way to Tollway (U.S. Route 20 to Illinois Route 53) as part of first tollable segment in 2016

IDOT to transfer remaining parcels acquired on behalf of the project to Tollway

Tollway to transfer right-of-way to IDOT for maintenance/jurisdiction responsibilities

IDOT/Tollway intergovernmental agreement to document transfer



Illinois Route 390 Land Transfer – DuPage County

County to transfer Thorndale Avenue right-of-way to Tollway

- \$25 million value of Thorndale Avenue parcels to be donated in-kind
- Parcel conveyance to occur on or before November 1, 2017


Tollway to transfer right-of-way to County for maintenance/jurisdiction responsibilities

- North Thorndale Avenue Arlington Heights Road to Prospect Avenue and from Mittel Boulevard to Supreme Drive – to be County Highway 60
- South Thorndale Avenue Arlington Heights Road to Prospect Avenue and from Mittel Boulevard to York Road – to be County Highway 61
- Parcels along county highways Prospect Avenue, Wood Dale Road, and York Road



Illinois Route 390 Land Transfer – Municipalities

Final proposed right-of-way maps distributed to agencies early September

Intergovernmental agreements to be pursued to transfer Illinois Route 390 right-ofway to appropriate jurisdictional owner, including:

- Itasca Crest Avenue, Meacham Road, Clover Ridge Lane, Hamilton Lakes Drive, Park Boulevard, Ketter Drive, Arlington Heights Road, South Thorndale Avenue from Hamilton Lakes Drive to Arlington Heights Road, North Thorndale Avenue from east of Prospect Avenue to Salt Creek
- Addison Township Parkside Avenue
- Wood Dale North Thorndale Avenue from east of Prospect Avenue and from Salt Creek to Mittel Boulevard, Mittel Boulevard, AEC Drive, Lively Boulevard
- Elk Grove Village Lively Boulevard
- Bensenville Supreme Drive and Driveway C

Transfers to occur after all right-of-way has been acquired (November 1, 2017) and construction is complete



Illinois Route 390 Jurisdictional Transfer

IDOT transferred jurisdiction of Elgin O'Hare Expressway (U.S. Route 20 to west of Park Boulevard) to Tollway as part of first tollable segment


DuPage County to transfer jurisdiction of Thorndale Avenue to the Tollway










Elgin O'Hare Corridor Bicycle & Pedestrian Plan: Project Study Area



Core Principles of the EOWA Bicycle-Pedestrian Plan

- 1. EOWA/IL 390 and I-355/I-290 will not be barriers to Non-Motorized travel
- 2. EOWA Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan will not recommend specific engineering improvements
- 3. EOWA Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan will be a multijurisdictional plan
- 4. Incorporate Municipal plans and programs




New bike lane installed on US 20 at IL 390


Recommendations Assessment


