The Tollway is required to use this contract for banking services including depository services, check-clearing services, information reporting, wire and ACH transfers, purchased rolled-coin services, and armored car delivery services.

This renewal request will therefore amend Resolution No. 22501 dated 7/20/22 by increasing the upper limit of compensation by \$200,000.00 for an additional two-year period. This represents the final renewal available under this contract. Prior to the expiration of this term, the Treasurer will issue a Request for Proposal to award a new banking contract.

Reason: This construction extra work order is for modifying a noise abatement wall based on actual site conditions. The underlying soil conditions encountered during construction differ from those anticipated at the time of noise abatement wall design. The soil testing conducted during the design phase was limited due to presence of dense vegetation and trees that restricted access. Additional testing has been conducted during construction after the existing vegetation and trees were removed and it has been determined that the noise abatement wall is required to be redesigned. To provide the necessary lateral stability, the noise abatement wall posts and foundations must be modified. The referenced noise abatement wall is being constructed along the northbound direction in conjunction with the roadway widening work and must be installed to meet commitments to adjacent residents and to achieve the necessary noise mitigation in accordance with Tollway requirements. The extra work includes labor, materials and equipment necessary to perform the extra work. The amount of the extra work order is estimated and only actual costs will be paid.

Scope: On July 11, 2022, the Tollway, the County and the Village entered into an intergovernmental agreement that identified each parties’ responsibilities relative to engineering, right-of-way acquisition, utility relocation, construction, financial participation, and maintenance for the Tollway-led portion (“Tollway Project”) of a proposed interchange on I-294 at 88th/Cork Avenue (“Interchange”).

In order to maximize the efficiency and safety of the Interchange, the County is leading a project involving necessary improvements to roadways adjacent to the Interchange, which are under the jurisdiction of the County, the Village or the Illinois Department of Transportation (“County Project”). This IGA identifies each parties’ responsibilities relative to engineering, right-of-way acquisition, utility relocation, construction, financial participation, and maintenance for the County Project.

Combined costs for the Tollway Project and the County Project (“Combined Project”) will be offset to determine the parties’ final cost participation. Per the Tollway’s Interchange Policy, the Tollway is providing 50% of the Combined Project’s cost, with the County and Village providing the remaining 50%.
