The Illinois Tollway is in year 13 of the 16-year, \$15 billion capital program, *Move Illinois: The Illinois Tollway Driving the Future*.

### **MOVE ILLINOIS PROGRAM BUDGET OVERVIEW (2012-2024)**

**\$12.8 billion** or **83.8**% of the program budget committed

58.0 billion, or approximately 52.4%, in construction work

53.1 billion, or approximately 20.4%, in consultant services

\$1.7 billion, or approximately 11.2%, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)

\$210.6 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by 1.4%















**I-490 CORRIDOR STATUS DIAGRAM** 






### **ILLINOIS ROUTE 390 AND I-490 BUDGET COMMITTED BY PHASE**






### 2024 MAINTENANCE FACILITY BUDGET




