# **MOVE ILLINOIS PROGRAM BUDGET OVERVIEW (2012-2024)**


**\$13.1 billion** or **85.9**% of the program budget committed

58.3 billion, or approximately 54.4%, in construction work

**53.1 billion**, or approximately **20.6%**, in consultant services

\$1.7 billion, or approximately 11.2%, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)

\$211.9 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by 1.4%











# **2024 PROJECT PROGRESS BY PHASE**








