## **MOVE ILLINOIS PROGRAM BUDGET OVERVIEW (2012-2024)**

\$13.1 billion or 86.0% of the program budget committed

58.3 billion, or approximately 54.5%, in construction work

**\$3.2 billion**, or approximately **20.6%**, in consultant services

\$1.7 billion, or approximately 11.2%, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)

\$211.9 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by 1.4% **77.3%** of the *Move Illinois* Program is complete (work in place)

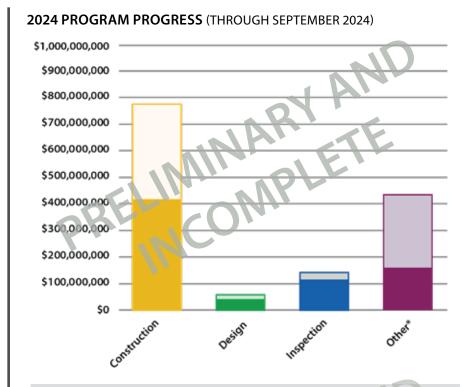

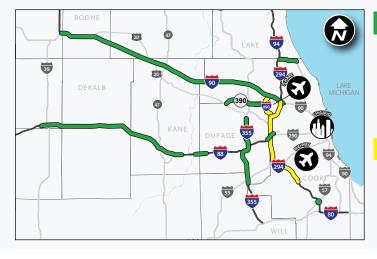

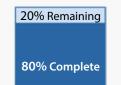

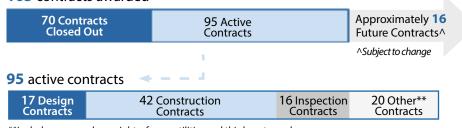

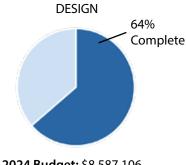

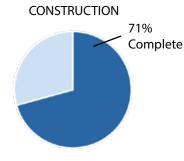

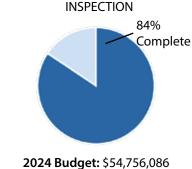

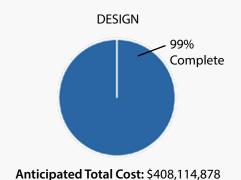

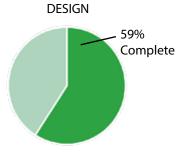

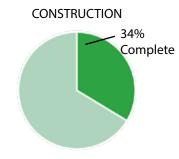

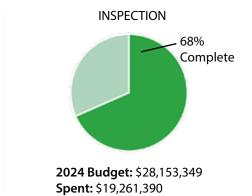

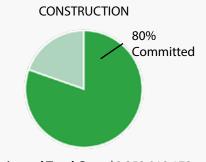


## **ILLINOIS ROUTE 390 AND I-490 BUDGET COMMITTED BY PHASE**

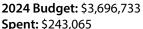


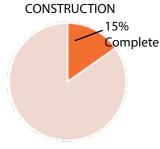




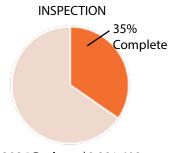
#### 2024 MAINTENANCE FACILITY BUDGET





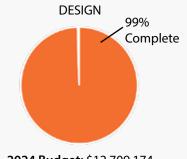

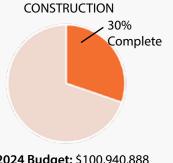
