MOVE ILLINOIS CAPITAL PROGRAM

DATA THROUGH NOVEMBER 2024

The Illinois Tollway is in year 13 of the 16-year, \$15 billion capital program, *Move Illinois: The Illinois Tollway Driving the Future*.

MOVE ILLINOIS PROGRAM BUDGET OVERVIEW (2012-2024)

\$13.2 billion or 86.0% of the program budget committed

58.4 billion, or approximately 55.0%, in construction work

\$3.2 billion, or approximately 20.7%, in consultant services

\$1.7 billion, or approximately 11.2%, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)

\$238.6 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by 1.6% **78.7%** of the *Move Illinois* Program is complete (work in place)

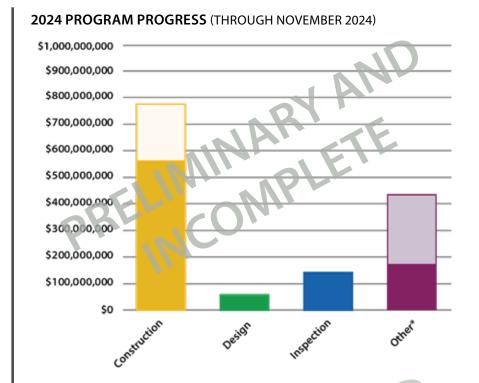

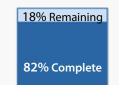

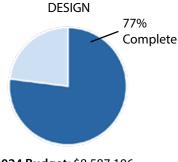

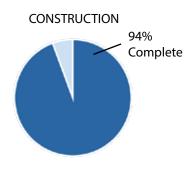

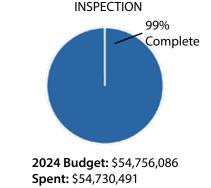

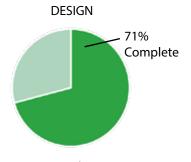

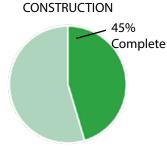

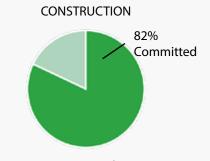


ILLINOIS ROUTE 390 AND I-490 BUDGET COMMITTED BY PHASE



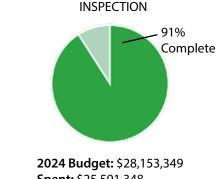
