The Illinois State Toll Highway Authority ("Tollway") held the regularly scheduled Engineering, Planning & Development Oversight Committee meeting on Thursday, September 19, 2024, in the Boardroom of Tollway headquarters in Downers Grove, Illinois. Committee Chair's Items

Chair McConnaughay entertained a motion to approve **Committee Chair's Item 1**, the minutes of the regular Engineering, Planning & Development Oversight Committee meeting held on August 29, 2024, as presented. Having no further items, Chair McConnaughay called on Executive Director Cassaundra Rouse.

Executive Director

Executive Director Rouse introduced Manar Nashif, Chief Engineering Officer, to present to the Committee an update on the Central Tri-State Project. See attached presentation.

Directors and staff discussed the Tollway's implementation of active traffic management, fiber optic infrastructure, and the systemwide use of Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS). They recommended implementing a communications plan to quantify and promote the benefits of the *Move Illinois* capital plan for the region, including enhanced mobility, reduced congestion, job creation, and economic development.

Upon conclusion of the presentation and discussion, Executive Director Rouse stated that the meeting agenda contains 5 items for the Committee's consideration.

Executive Director Rouse asked Chief Engineering Officer Manar Nashif to present to the Committee the following items:

<u>Item 1</u>: Extra Work Order on I-21-4738 to Lorig Construction Company for Railroad Track Relocation, Retaining Wall Construction, Earthwork Excavation on the Elgin O'Hare Western Access Tollway (I-490) South of Grand Avenue to Irving Park Road (IL 19), Tri-State Tollway (I-294) to Franklin Avenue, Mile Post 5.6 (Touhy Avenue IL 72) to Mile Post 5.75 (Old Higgins Road) in the amount of \$3,800,000.00, increasing the upper limit of compensation from \$124,364,114.95 to \$128,164,114.95.

<u>Item 2</u>: Change Order / Extra Work Order on I-22-4867 to Walsh Construction Company II, LLC for Substructure Removal Southbound Mile Long Bridge on the Tri-State Tollway (I-294) between Mile Post 21.1 and Mile Post 21.3 in the amount of \$1,150,000.00, increasing the upper limit of compensation from \$2,219,712.12 to \$3,369,712.12.

<u>Item 3</u>: Acceptance of Proposal from R.M. Chin & Associates, Inc. on Contract I-24-4759 for Construction Management Services on the Elgin O'Hare Western Access (I-490) along Irving Park Road (IL 19) between York Road and Taft Avenue in an amount not to exceed \$4,772,667.52.




