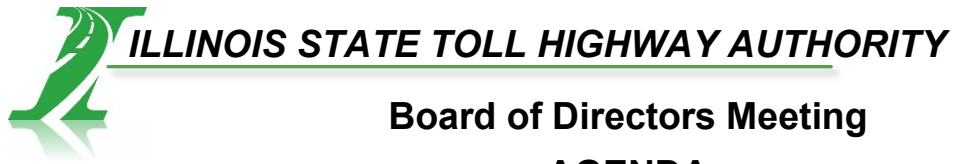

Description: Property Insurance Program Services

Scope: The Finance Department recommends acceptance of a proposal for Property Insurance Coverage for the assets of the Tollway including, but not limited to, bridges, structures, and business interruption coverage for loss of toll income through RSUI Indemnity Company, Westchester Fire Insurance Company, Lloyd’s of London (Terrorism), Westchester Surplus Lines Insurance Company (Earthquake), SiriusPoint America Insurance Company (Auto Physical Damage), and the Tollway’s Central Administration facility, electronic data processing, and toll equipment through Federal Insurance Company. The current policies expire on April 1, 2025.

The primary insurance broker for these policies will be Mesirow Insurance Services, Inc. (Alliant Insurance Services, Inc.) with a BEP partner, Cynasure Insurance, and Maximum Independent Brokerage LLC, the wholesale broker for the program.

Request approval for one year of coverage from April 1, 2025, to April 1, 2026 obtained through the CMS Master Contract for Insurance Brokerage Services.
