Description:	Extension of Pilot Program Regarding Toll Evasion Fines
Scope:	The Toll Highway Act authorizes the Illinois Tollway to "fix, assess, and collect civil fines for a vehicle's operation on a toll highway without the required toll having been paid." 605 ILCS 10/10(a-5). Pursuant to Section 10/10(a-5) of the Act, the Illinois Tollway previously established rules for, among other things, escalated fines, which are set forth in 92 Ill. Admin. Code §§ 2520.750(a) and (b). The escalated fine for toll violations on the Elgin-O'Hare Tollway (IL-390) is \$25.00 per violation. The escalated fine for toll violations on other Tollway toll roads is \$50.00 per violation. The escalated fine for toll violations on other Tollway toll roads is \$50.00 per violation. The scalated fine for any or all classes of vehicles for the time period specified in [a Board] Resolution." 92 Ill. Admin. Code § 2520.750(b)(2). In July 2022, the Tollway Board authorized a three-year pilot program suspending escalated fines. The pilot program expires on June 30, 2025. For various reasons, the Tollway needs additional time to consider the impact of eliminating escalated fines. Therefore, it seeks to extend the pilot program, the Board will determine whether to discontinue, modify or continue its escalated fine policy and will amend its rules to reflect its decision. <i>See</i> 92 Ill. Admin. Code § 2520.750(b)(2).

Description:	Approval of Expenditure in Support of Expressway Camera Act
Scope:	By the Expressway Camera Act, 605 ILCS 140/1, <i>et seq.</i> , the Illinois legislature established a program to increase the number of automated license plate reader ("ALPR") cameras on State highways and expressways in designated Illinois counties. The program, which involves the Illinois State Police ("ISP"), the Illinois Department of Transportation, and The Illinois State Toll Highway Authority, is intended to facilitate: (i) the investigation of offenses involving vehicular hijacking, aggravated vehicular hijacking, terrorism, motor vehicle theft, and forcible felonies, including, but not limited to, offenses involving the use of a firearm, (ii) the detection of expressway hazards and adverse highway conditions, and (iii) law enforcement's efforts to enhance highway safety and incident management.
	The Tollway endorses and fully supports the purposes of the Expressway Camera Act, which will enhance safety on Tollway toll roads. Accordingly, consistent with the Act, the Tollway seeks to provide funds needed to implement the program established by the Act on roads under the Tollway's jurisdiction. Accordingly, it is recommended that the Tollway devote an amount, not to exceed \$700,000, to procure, install and maintain feeds from ALPR cameras on Tollway toll roads in counties identified in the Act to ISP's ALPR system, and pay for related matters intended to further the purposes of the Act on Tollway toll roads.

Scope: The Illinois State Toll Highway Authority ("Tollway") owns property throughout northern Illinois, including a gun range located at 3460 S. Among other things, the IGA (i) grants ISP (with limited exception), exclusive access to the Gun Range, (ii) renders ISP responsible for all utility, repair, insurance and routine maintenance costs at the Gun Range, including costs relating to OSHA requirements, (iii) renders ISP responsible for safety at the Gun Range, and (iv) to the extent permitted by law, requires ISP to indemnify, hold harmless and defend the Tollway against any claims, suits and causes of action that arise out of or are caused by the actions or inactions of ISP employees, agents or invitees while at the Gun Range or on Tollway-owned property, other than Tollway toll roads.

Amount: Cost to the Tollway: The ISP will reimburse the Tollway for insurance premiums and other costs relating to its use of Tollway property.
