RAMP AT ILLINOIS ROUTE 83 ON REAGAN MEMORIAL TOLLWAY (I-88) SCHEDULED TO REOPEN WHILE WORK CONTINUES TO REPAIR BRIDGE

Repair work expected to continue into fall, additional ramp closures and detours will be needed to complete work

DOWNERS GROVE, IL – The ramp connecting the westbound Reagan Memorial Tollway (I-88) to southbound Illinois Route 83 is scheduled to reopen to traffic tonight, June 10, as repair work continues on the Illinois Route 83 Bridge.

After the ramp reopens, one northbound lane, the shoulder and a portion of the left turn lane on northbound Illinois Route 83 will remain closed. All lanes on southbound Illinois Route 83 remain open. All lanes on I-88 also remain open.

Work is underway to remove and replace damaged beams and repair damage caused when the underside of the Illinois Route 83 Bridge was struck by a construction excavator being hauled by a truck/trailer in late May. Repair work is expected to continue into the fall.

Additional closures and detours of the westbound I-88 to southbound Illinois Route 83 ramp will be needed later this year to accommodate new bridge beam placement to complete the repair work.

The Tollway is coordinating repair work with the Illinois Department of Transportation and local municipalities.

About the Illinois Tollway

The Illinois Tollway is a user-fee system that receives no state or federal funds for maintenance and operations. The agency maintains and operates 294 miles of roadways in 12 counties in Northern Illinois, including the Reagan Memorial Tollway (I-88), the Veterans Memorial Tollway (I-355), the Jane Addams Memorial Tollway (I-90), the Tri-State Tollway (I-94/I-294/I-80) and the Illinois Route 390 Tollway.
