
\$13.5 billion or 88.6% of the program budget committed

58.6 billion, or approximately 56.5%, in construction work

\$3.2 billion, or approximately **21.0%**, in consultant services

\$1.7 billion, or approximately 11.2%, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)

\$273.6 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by 1.8%






CORRIDOR STATUS DIAGRAM






















