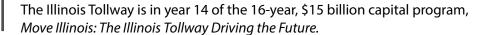

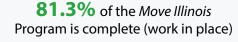
**\$13.6 billion** or **89.4**% of the program budget committed

\$8.6 billion, or approximately 56.7%, in construction work

53.2 billion, or approximately 21.0%, in consultant services

\$1.7 billion, or approximately 11.2%, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)

\$261.9 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by 1.7%

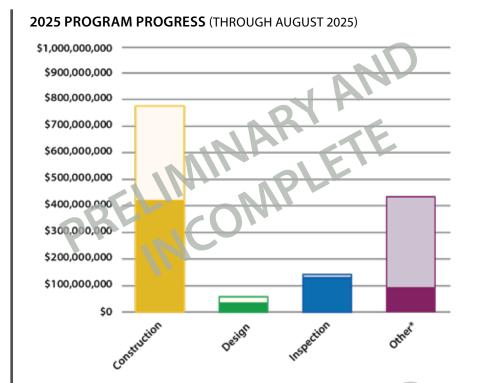

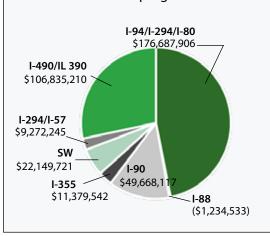

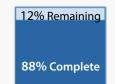

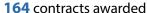

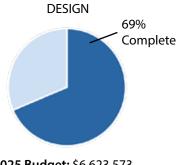

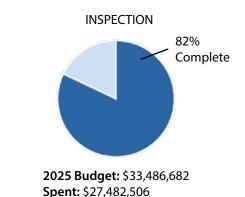

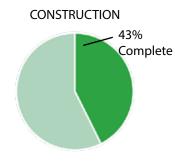

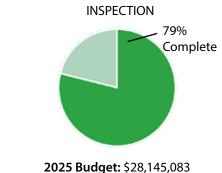
