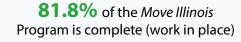

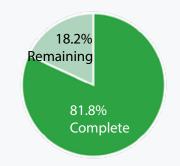

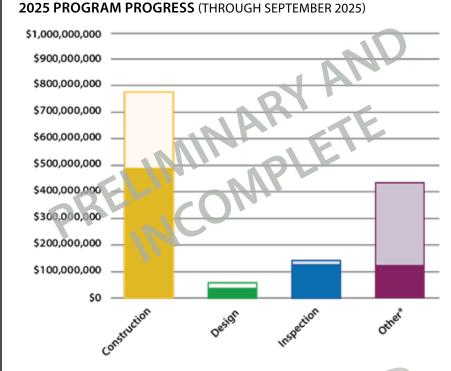

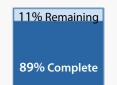

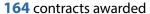

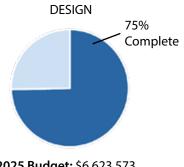

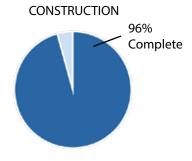

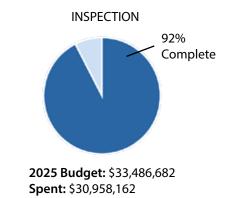

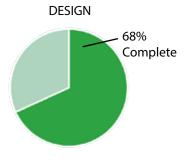

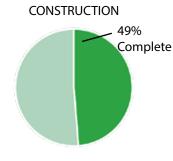

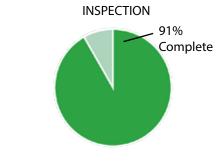

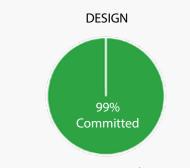

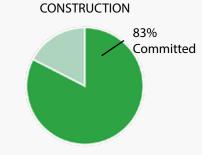

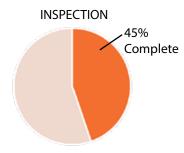
2025 MAINTENANCE FACILITY BUDGET

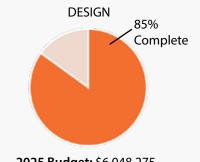

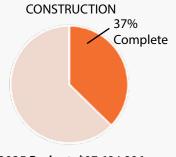

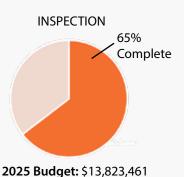
