The Illinois Tollway is in receipt of your FOIA request dated July 5, 2018. In that request, you asked for the following items:

1. Current plan for Rt 53 (FAP 342) at Half Day Road;
2. Proposed Right of Way map of the widening of Tri-State Tollway (I-294); and
3. Ordinances on resolutions authorizing land acquisition from January 1, 2018-present.

In response to Item 1 of your request, the Tollway has no responsive records.
