**Re: FOIA 18-0190**

Dear Mr. Phillips:

The Illinois Tollway is in receipt of your FOIA request dated July 13, 2018. In that request, you asked for the following items:

1. Since 3/14/17 how many EO/Ls have had at least one instance of the paycode "WC-IOJ" listed on their time sheet?
2. Of those EO/Ls (that have had WC-IOJ listed on their time sheet at any point from 3/14/17 through present day), how many have been denied workers compensation benefits?
3. How many EO/Ls currently being pay coded as WC-IOJ are being denied workers compensation benefits.
4. Of all the EO/L injuries that have taken place since 3/14/17, what is the average amount of time it has taken the Tollway, or their work comp vendor Corvel, to render a decision in regards to an employee's injury claim. ex. I was injured on 3/14/17, but was not given a decision until 10/6/17; 7 months after the fact.
5. What's the mean/average amount of time it takes for an EO/L to be given a decision regarding their claim?
6. What is the least amount of time that has been taken to render a decision?
7. What is the longest amount of time that has been taken to render a decision?

We have completed our review and have no records responsive to your request.
