I-294 CORRIDOR PLANNING COUNCIL
October 15, 2015 – Meeting Summary

The third meeting of the Central Tri-State Tollway (I-294) Corridor Planning Council took place Thursday, October 15, 2015, at the Oak Brook Village Hall. Illinois Tollway Deputy Chief of Engineering for Planning Rocco Zuccherro and Oak Brook Village Trustee Asif Yusif welcomed the Council followed by a call for public comments, of which there were none.

Rocco Zuccherro led a brief presentation outlining the agenda for the meeting, and he reviewed the discussion from the Lessons Learned meeting. Bryan Wagner, Environmental Policy and Program Manager, presented a recap of the second Environmental Working Group meeting that was held September 29.

Aimee Lee, Senior Manager of Strategic Planning, led a discussion on the potential solutions to the major issue areas that the Council members produced in the prior meeting. From this discussion CPC staff will work the potential solutions into draft recommendations.

Council members were then broken out into small groups to prioritize the issues and opportunities previously identified by Council members and stakeholders. These issues included: congestion, flooding and drainage, freight and freight diversion, system access, economic development, aesthetics, pedestrian and bicycle amenities, noise and technology. After a recap of the prioritization, the meeting adjourned.

The next Corridor Planning Council will take place Tuesday, November 10, 2015, at 1:00 p.m. at the Lipinski Community Center in Justice.
