It has been brought to our attention that there is an <u>in-car video</u> by State Trooper C. Lambert of the crash. Pursuant to the provision of the Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS140/1, we ask that you provide us with a copy of any and all still photographs, digital photographs, and digital video recording depicting any images of the occurrence.

In light of the fact that the video recordings, digital photographs, etc., will likely be important evidence in anticipation litigation, we hereby demand that you or any other person or entity with control of these items take all steps necessary to preserve any video and/or film recordings.

I understand that the Act, pursuant to 5 ILCS 140/6, permits a public body to charge a reasonable copying fee not to exceed the actual cost of reproduction and not including the costs of any search or review of the records, and agree to pay any statutory costs for providing these documents.

I look forward to hearing from you via email or in writing within seven (7) working days, as required by the Act (5 ILCS 140/3).
