Dear Mr. Blevins:

The Illinois Tollway is in receipt of your FOIA request for “copies of any certified payroll provided by Highway Safety Corporation for work performed on any Illinois Tollway Construction project during the year 2012, as well as any affidavit filed by Highway Safety Corporation that the company was in compliance with the Project Labor Agreement for worked performed on any Illinois Tollway Construction Project during the year 2012.”

In the process of completing our review of your request, we have identified additional records for your request (contract RR-11-5625), however, they located in off-site storage and there is a \$30 fee to retrieve those records. If you would like to receive these records, payment can be made to the Illinois Tollway, Attn: FOIA Officer, 2700 Ogden Avenue, Downers Grove, IL, 60515. The records will be processed upon receipt of payment.

The Illinois Tollway has completed its review of the records available on site and the responsive records are included with this response.

Please note that your request and it is granted in part and denied in part. The Tollway has redacted private information including personal addresses and social security numbers. Individual's personal addresses and social security numbers are exempt under Section 7(1)(b) which allows the Agency to redact individuals' private information. " 'Private information' means unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5)

Please note that Joelle McGinnis, Freedom of Information Officer, was responsible for the denials referenced herein. You have a right to have the denial of your request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You also have the right to seek judicial review of your denial by filing a lawsuit in the State circuit court. 5 ILCS 140/11.

If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this denial letter. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this denial letter when filing a Request for Review with the PAC.
