We have completed the review of your request. Enclosed with this letter are copies of the responsive records.

The Tollway has redacted private information including personal addresses, employee identification numbers and social security numbers. Individual's personal addresses, employee identification numbers and social security numbers are exempt under Section 7(1)(b) which allows the Agency to redact individuals' private information. " 'Private information' means unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5)

Please note that Joelle McGinnis, Freedom of Information Officer, was responsible for the denials referenced herein. You have a right to have the denial of your request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a).
