

Project Update







- First interstate-to-interstate connection on the Tollway system where there is no toll collection point for customers who wish to pay cash
- More than 87 percent of Tollway transactions are I-PASS
- Above average I-PASS penetration in Chicago Southland communities
- Goal: Provide everyone the opportunity to benefit from the new interchange and make traveling on it as easy as possible



MOVE

- Extended, limited-time toll payment offer
- **▶ Temporary I-PASS Customer Service Center**
- ▶ I-PASS roadshow tour in the Chicago Southland
- Others?





- Intended to help customers without I-PASS who use the new interchange and may be from another state or unfamiliar with the Tollway
- Provides 30 days to pay from the date of the unpaid toll
- For I-294/I-57 and I-294 at 147th Street ramps (Plaza 42) toll payments only
- **Expires December 31, 2014**






- Temporary I-PASS Customer Service Center
- Intended to serve local residents who wish to obtain I-PASS
- Open from September 2 to November 26, Tuesday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Full-service operation staffed with Tollway Customer Service Representatives
- Located in the Secretary of State Office in Midlothian



Nearby Customer Service Center Locations






I-PASS Roadshow Tour

Customers Traveling South on I-294

- MOVE
- Signage begins three miles from the interchange
- Signage every half mile
 - Five sign trusses (overhead, shoulder, median)
 - Two cantilever signs
 - Two ground-mounted signs








- ▶ Take the ramp up to I-57 South
- Drive under the toll gantry
- Pay toll with I-PASS, E-Z Pass or pay online
- Exit the Tollway and merge onto I-57 South
