

# U.S. Route 20 (Lake Street) Interchange and Illinois Route 390 Tollway Improvement Study


## Public Information Meeting #1 - August 20, 2019

### Purpose of this Meeting

### Project Overview

In coordination with the Village of Hanover Park, the Illinois Tollway is conducting a Preliminary Engineering and Environmental Study for the U.S. Route 20 (Lake Street) Interchange at Illinois Route 390 (IL 390) Tollway Improvement. The existing interchange at U.S. Route 20 (U.S. 20) is the west terminus of the IL 390 Tollway. The project will determine if extending the IL 390 interchange ramps to County Farm Road can address local traffic issues.

### Study Process

The study is following the National Environmental Policy Act, which requires an evaluation of the effects of the project and must follow a project development process consisting of three phases. We are currently in the initial stages of Phase I, which is anticipated to conclude by the end of 2020. The timeframe to start Phase II and Phase III are to be determined based on available funding. The Phase I Study consists of:

- Collect data
- Conduct stakeholder and public involvement
- Analyze existing conditions
- Determine project needs and purpose
- Perform environmental and drainage studies
- Develop and analyze alternatives
- Identify preferred alternative
- Analyze traffic noise




Project Implementation Process

## Existing Conditions

The Village of Hanover Park would like to remove the through traffic from Greenbrook Boulevard by extending the interchange to move the traffic directly to County Farm Road. Morning peak-hour traffic on Greenbrook Boulevard conflicts with the school bus, car, bike and pedestrian traffic to the schools located on Greenbrook Boulevard and can result in potential safety issues.
