MOVE ILLINOIS CAPITAL PROGRAM

DATA THROUGH MARCH 2020

In 2012, the Illinois Tollway launched the 15-year, \$12 billion capital program, *Move Illinois: The Illinois Tollway Driving the Future*. In 2017, the Board of Directors expanded the program to \$14 billion.


\$8.3 billion or **58.3**% of the program budget committed

54.6 billion, or approximately **32.2%,** in construction work

52.5 billion, or approximately 17.3%, in consultant services

\$1.2 billion, or approximately 8.8%, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)

\$173.4 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by 1.2% **45.6%** of the *Move Illinois* program is complete (work in place)

















2020 PROJECT PROGRESS BY PHASE - YEAR TO DATE








ILLINOIS ROUTE 390 AND I-490 BUDGET COMMITTED BY PHASE










2020 MAINTENANCE FACILITY BUDGET




