This form is now required from the lowest apparent bidder on the fifth (5th) calendar day after bids are due or the bid will be deemed non-responsive. No other changes have been made to the process or content of this form.

**ISTHA Form 2025-Participation Statement Form**: This form is now required from the lowest apparent bidder on the fifth (5th) calendar day after bids are due or the bid will be deemed non-responsive

#### NEW SUBCONTRACTOR ACCESS IN THE TOLLWAY'S CAPTURE SYSTEM

All subcontractors on current Tollway construction and related contracts now have access to the Tollway's Capture system to provide required EEO information to the Tollway. Subcontractors are now able to use the Capture system to report work hours and run reports for those hours. In order to obtain access, subcontractors must complete and submit the Capture Access Form (attached) to the Contract Compliance Analyst assigned to their contract and accounts will be set up for them in the system.

Please note that the new Capture system functionality does not change prime contractors' access level nor limit their ability to report work hours and run reports for their subcontractors. Prime contractors that choose to report work hours for their subcontractors may continue to do so. This change of access does not alleviate the prime contractor from primary responsibility for ensuring that all data is properly entered on time.

For your convenience, please find attached the Capture User Manual which provides a step-by-step guide on how to report work hours in the system. If you have questions or need additional help on how to navigate the Tollway's Capture system, please contact the Contract Compliance Analyst assigned to your contract.
