

## ILLINOIS ROUTE 390/I-490 TOLLWAYS

The Illinois Route 390 Tollway originally opened in 2017, streamlining access to the west side of O’Hare International Airport and the industry surrounding it. Illinois Route 390 will connect to the I-490 Tollway that is currently under construction around the western side of O’Hare Airport. Upon completion, Illinois Route 390 and I-490 will provide a crucial western bypass for the heavily congested area surrounding O’Hare Airport. **The capital program anticipates an \$833 million investment in IL 390/I-490.**

<b>I-490 West Landside Reserve Improvements</b>	Develop a landside reserve area in coordination with the Chicago Department of Aviation to support a TSA screening facility, employee parking, security features and direct Tollway access connections near O’Hare.
