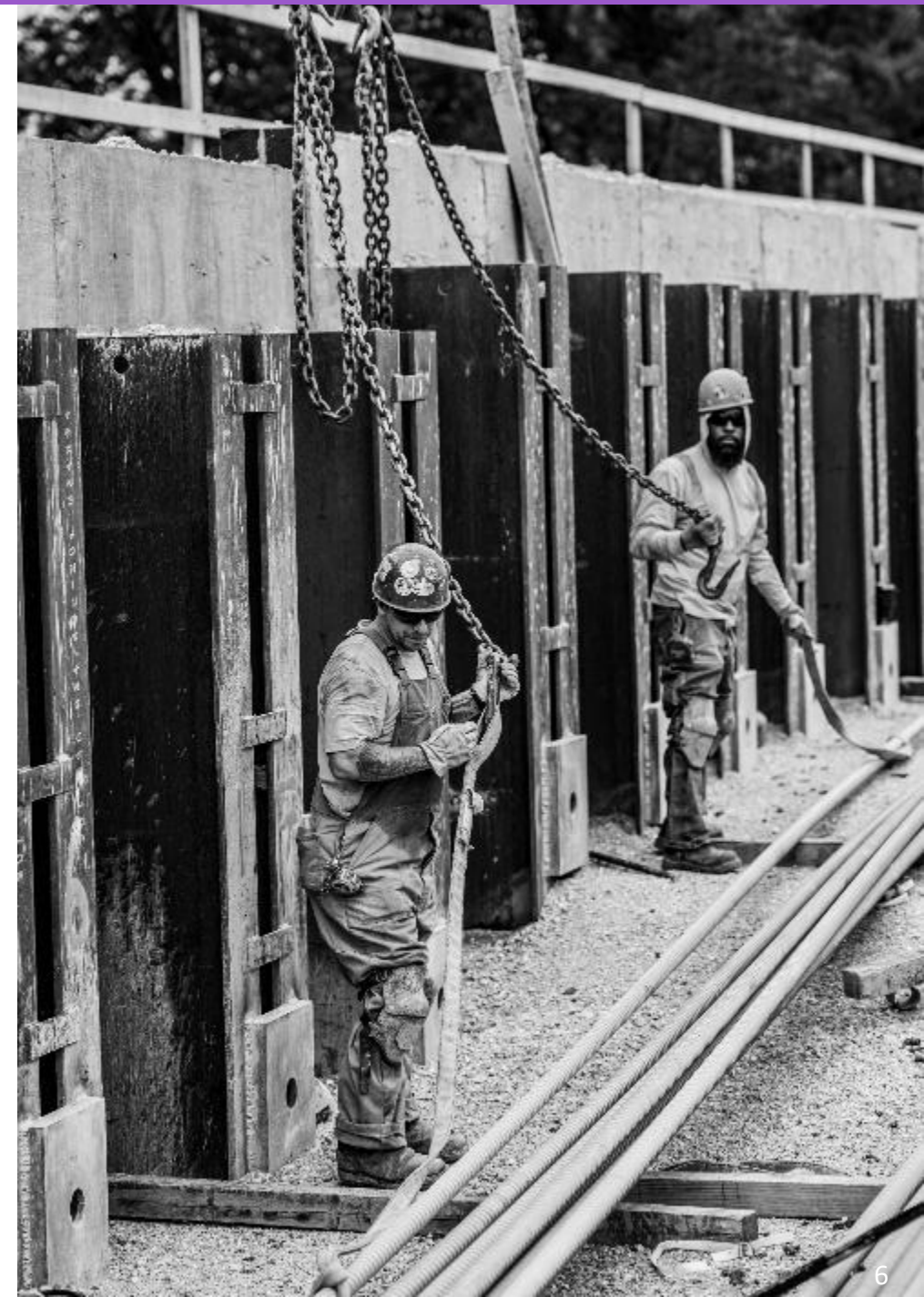

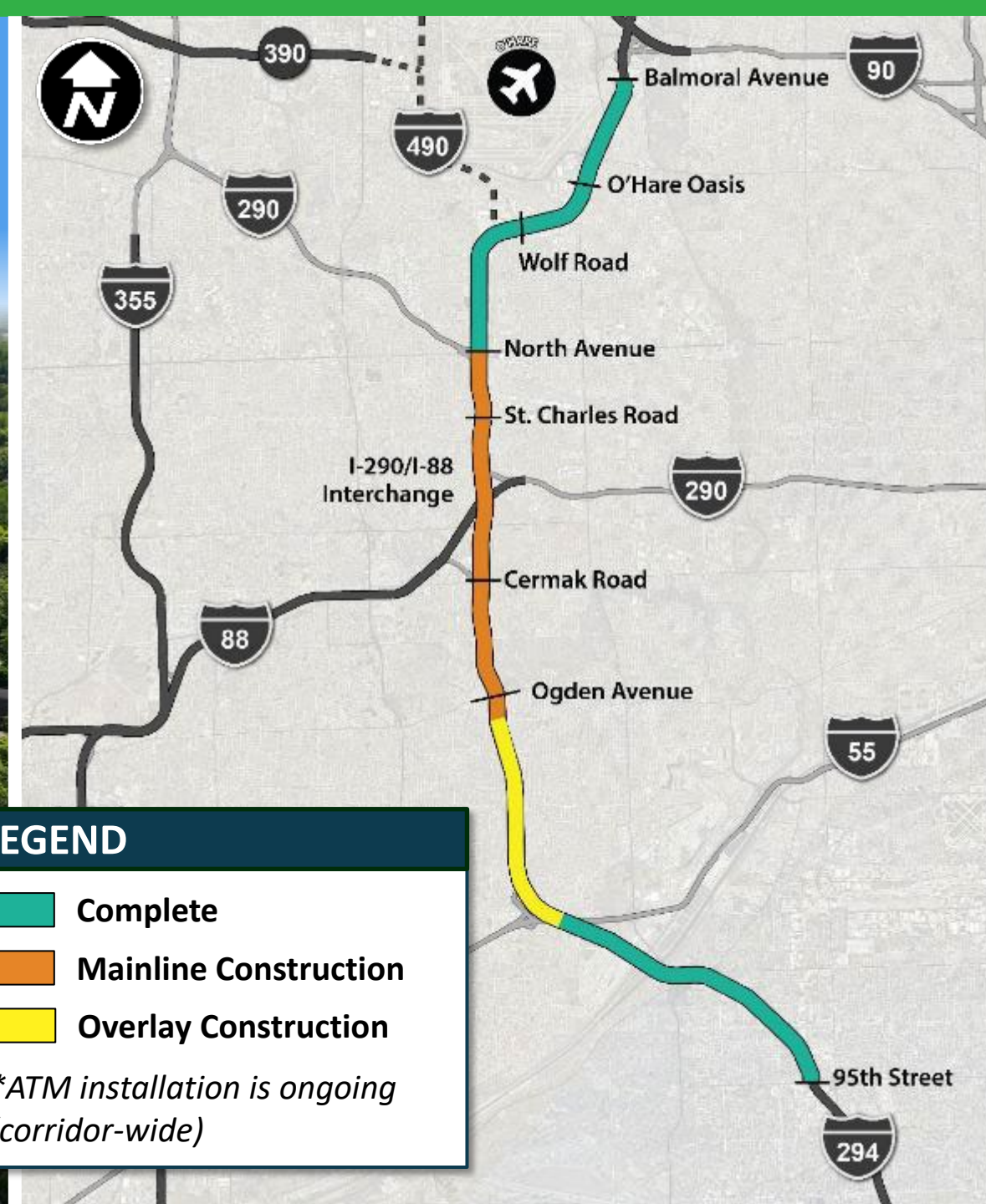

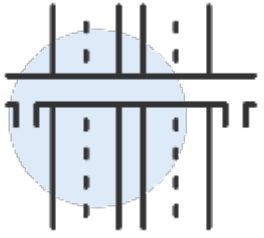

- ▶ I-355 – Roosevelt Road to North Avenue



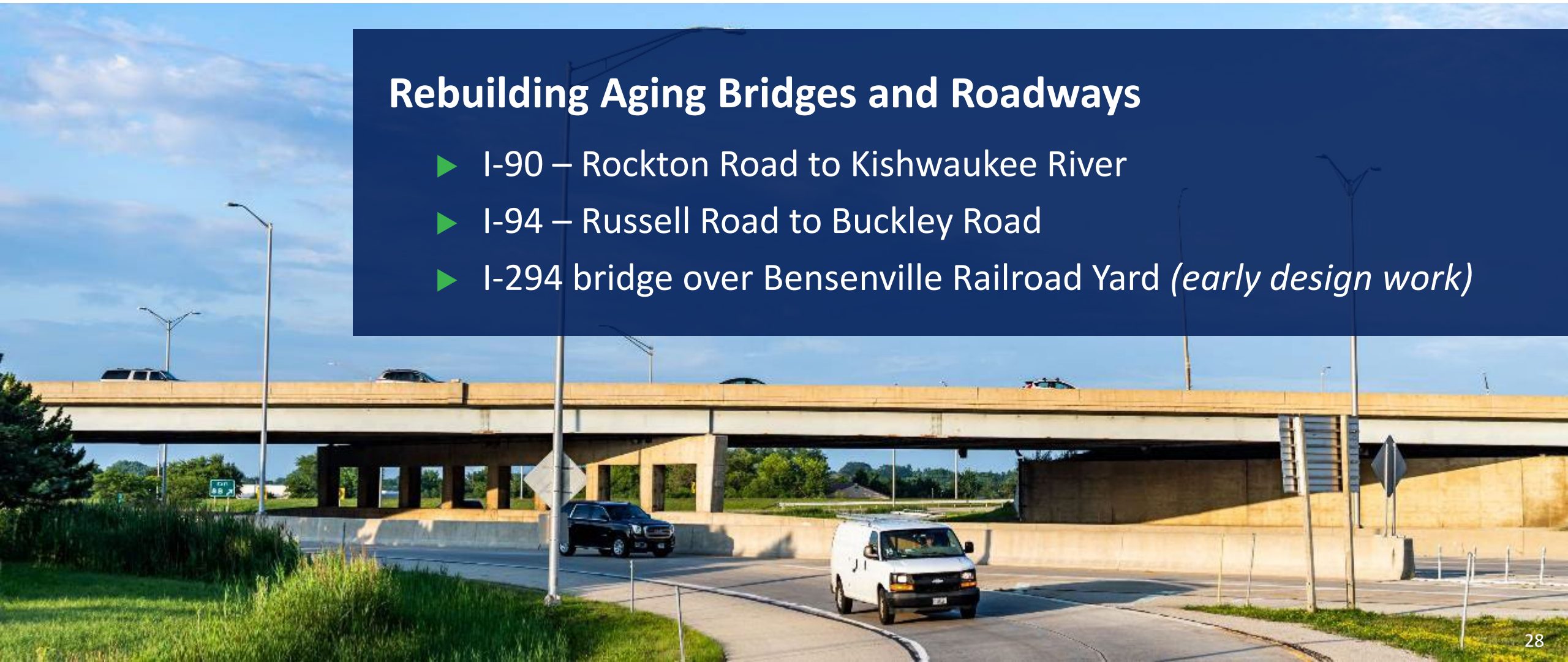


INFRASTRUCTURE RENEWAL

- ▶ I-294 bridge over Bensenville Railroad Yard (*early design work*)

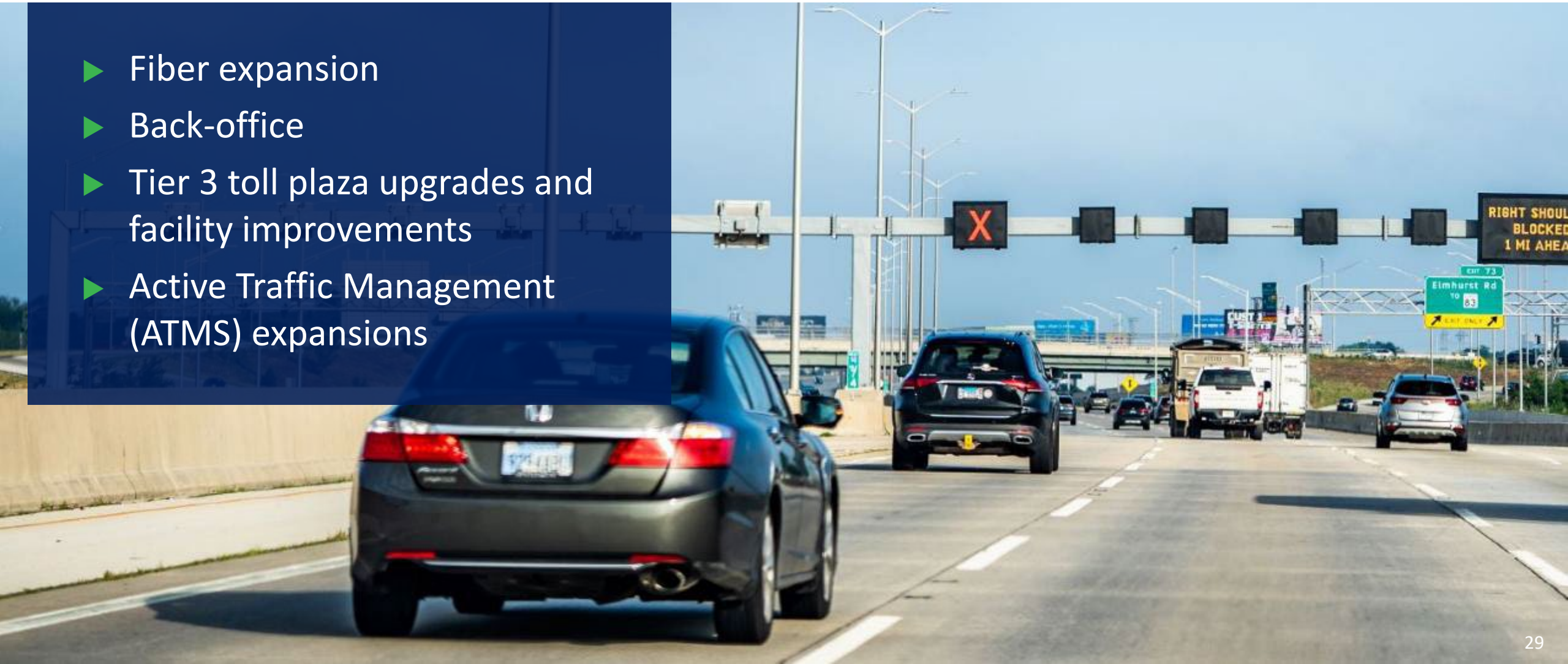

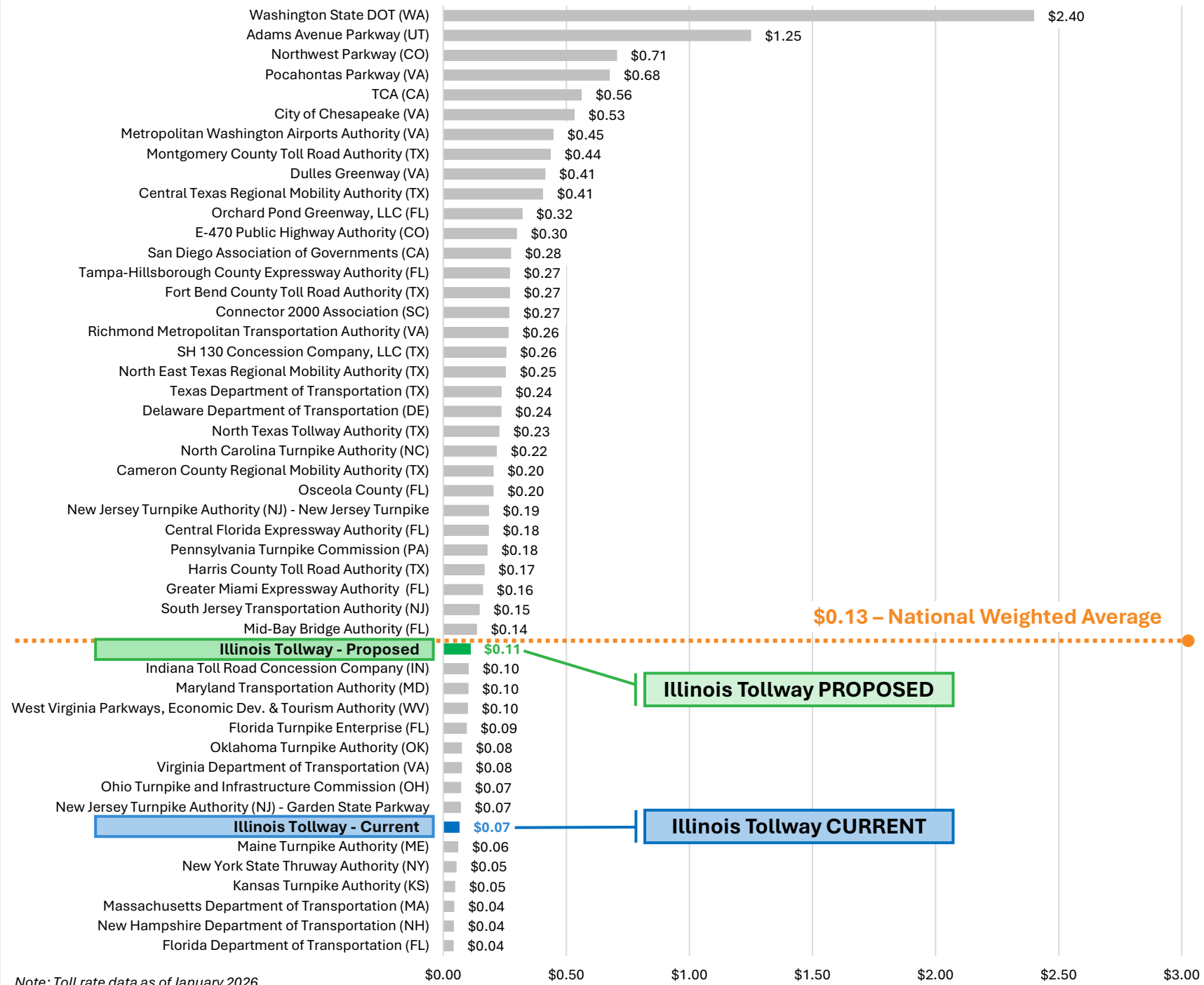

How the Illinois Tollway Compares Nationally



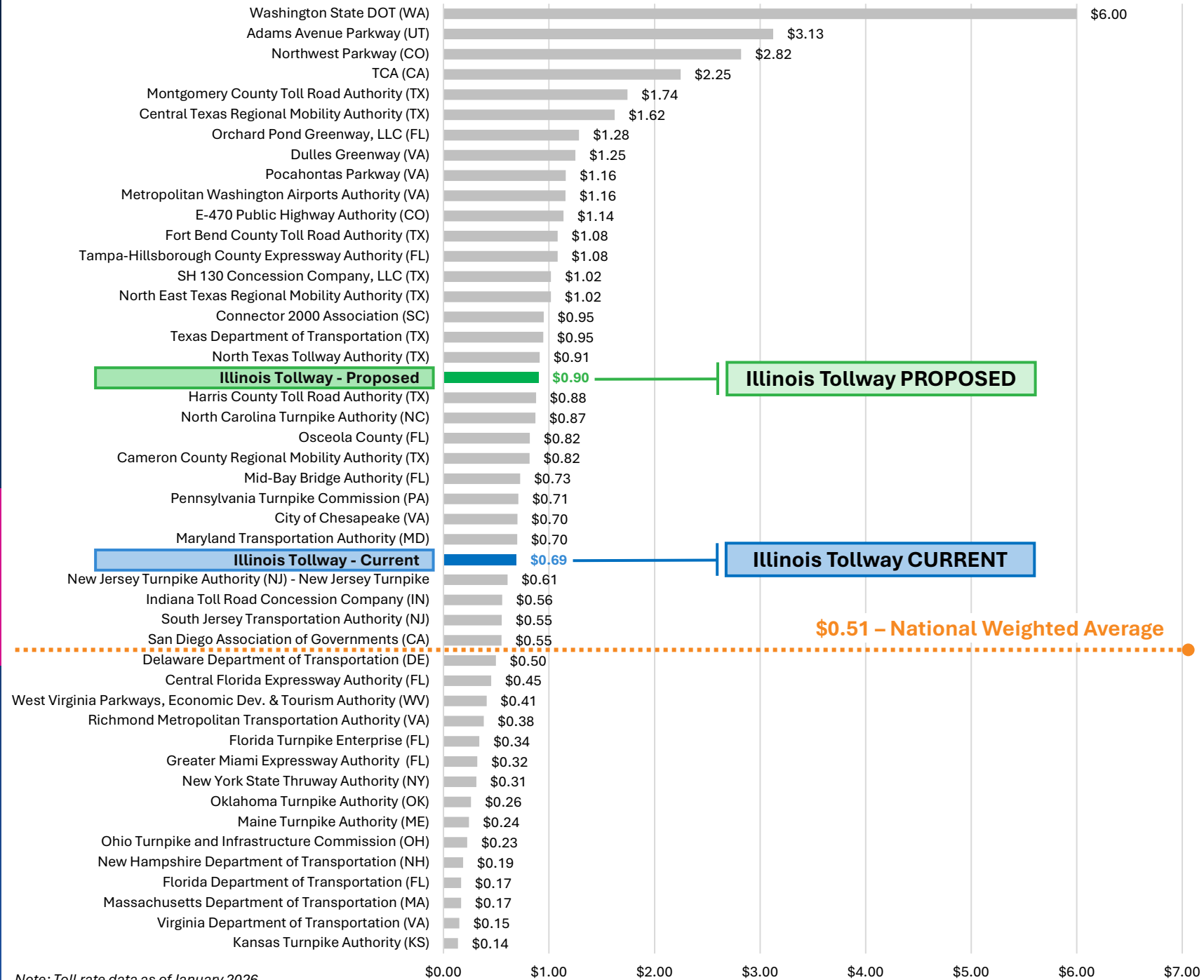
Passenger Vehicles
