

Tri-State Tollway (I-294) near Irving Park Road (Illinois Route 19) *Phase I Engineering Study*

Public Meeting #1 Summary

October 8, 2024




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1 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The existing Central Tri-State Tollway (I-294) at Irving Park Road (IL Route 19) interchange provides I-294 access to and from the north only. In November 2018, the Illinois Tollway initiated a Feasibility Study to evaluate opportunities for additional I-294 access near IL Route 19 to and from the south. The outcome of that Feasibility Study was identification of an apparent best performing alternative with a recommendation for moving forward with additional engineering studies. To maximize funding options and ensure that potential impacts are considered, the Illinois Tollway (Tollway) in conjunction with the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) initiated Phase I Engineering and Environmental Studies (Phase I Study) to consider improvement alternatives based on updated 2050 traffic projections, complete more detailed environmental studies, and pursue additional stakeholder coordination. The Phase I Study is being completed in accordance with IDOT requirements to ensure future federal funding opportunities, along with review and approval of the Tollway. One of the first steps in the stakeholder involvement process is to engage the public at large through a Public Meeting, which is advertised to communities in and around the project study area.

The first Public Meeting (PM #1) for the I-294 near IL Route 19 Interchange Improvement Phase I Study was held on Tuesday, October 8, 2024, from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. in the Village of Schiller Park Community Center located at 4501 25th Avenue, Schiller Park, IL 60176. The purpose of this meeting was to present the project history, the scope and schedule for the current Phase I Study, work completed to date, and to solicit input on issues and opportunities in the project study area. This in-person, open house event provided attendees with the opportunity to engage directly with the project study team, the Tollway, and IDOT. Multiple Tollway and IDOT representatives attended PM #1 along with representatives from the Phase I consultant team. A Community Advisory Group (CAG) has been established to facilitate project coordination with the adjacent communities of Schiller Park and Franklin Park, and involved agencies, which is highlighted within the PM #1 materials. Multiple CAG members also attended PM #1 to interact with meeting attendees.

Methods used to notify the public of PM #1 included placement of meeting announcements (display ads) in the Chicago Sun Times (Schiller Park) on September 17th and October 1st, and in the Franklin Park Herald-Journal (Suburban Tribune - Franklin Park) on September 19th and October 3rd, a digital message posted at the Illinois Tollway Website, a press release published by the Illinois Tollway, letter invitations to elected officials and agency representatives, and postcards to adjacent residents and businesses in the Phase I Study area.

Information was provided at PM #1 regarding the project development process and timeline, the public involvement process, the project purpose and need, the existing and projected traffic conditions within the study area, the previous feasibility study findings, the proposed alternatives and public feedback opportunities. Attendees had the opportunity to review exhibits, provide comments via a project comment form, and talk directly to project study team representatives.

PM #1 was attended by approximately 60 people. The comment period extended through October 25th for comments to be added to the formal PM #1 record. Eighteen (18) comments were received by this date and are discussed later in the PM #1 summary.

2 MEETING NOTIFICATIONS

2.1 NEWSPAPER DISPLAY ADS AND PRESS RELEASE


Public notice via newspaper display ads were placed in the Chicago Sun Times (Schiller Park) on September 17th and October 1st, and in the Franklin Park Herald-Journal (Suburban Tribune - Franklin Park) on September 19th and October 3rd. Certifications of these publications are included in **Attachment A**.

Additionally, the Illinois Tollway published a press release with all the information regarding the project and PM #1 which is also included in **Attachment A**.

2.2 COMMUNITY LETTER INVITATIONS AND POST CARDS

In total 367 postcards were sent to businesses and residents of Schiller Park and Franklin Park. Additionally, 49 letters were mailed to various agencies and organizations connected to the project. Finally, 56 letters were sent to elected officials of the communities, including Village of Schiller Park, Village of Franklin Park, State of Illinois, Cook County, City of Chicago and Layden Township. 3 MEETING SUMMARY

PM #1 was held on Tuesday, October 8, 2024, from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. in the Village of Schiller Park Community Center located at 4501 25th Avenue, Schiller Park, IL 60176. The purpose of this meeting was to present the project history, the scope and schedule for the current Phase I Study, work completed to date, and to solicit input on issues and opportunities in the project study area. The public meeting was held in an open house format so that interested people could attend at any time during this time period, to review project exhibits, gather information on the project, discuss issues and opportunities with the project study team (Tollway, IDOT, Consultant Team), and provide written comments on the project.

Information was provided at the open house regarding the project development process and timeline, the public involvement process, the project purpose and need, the existing and projected traffic conditions within the study area, the previous feasibility study findings, the proposed alternatives and public feedback opportunities.

Meeting materials included a project brochure at the sign-in table, 24-inch x 36-inch exhibits set up throughout the space presenting key project components, physical copies of the complete 2021 Feasibility Study for review, and large-scale maps of the project area to facilitate discussion.


At the entrance, each attendee signed in by providing a name, representing entity and contact information. Attendees were encouraged to follow the station numbers in order as they walked through the open house so that they would gather as much information about the project and study process prior to providing comments:

- Station 1 – Project Overview and Phase I Engineering Process: A project overview was presented by the engineering consultants, including a project map, project development process, and project development timeline.
- Station 2 – Public Involvement Process: Attendees were introduced to the Context Sensitive Solutions (CSS) Stakeholder Involvement Process and the draft Purpose and Need Statement, developed by the Community Advisory Group (CAG).

- **Station 3 – Project Analysis and Range of Alternatives:** Representatives of the project study group presented the potential design alternative that was recommended in the 2021 Feasibility Study, the findings of recent traffic studies, relevant safety data, and identified environmental resources in the project study area
- **Station 4 – Issues/Concerns and Alternatives:** Large-scale aerial based maps of the project area were displayed on tables to promote discussion between the project study team and attendees.
- **Station 5 – Comments:** Each attendee was encouraged to fill out a comment form, with any thoughts, concerns or comments regarding the project.

Throughout all stations, representatives from the Tollway, IDOT, the Consultant Team, and CAG members in attendance, were available to discuss the project with meeting attendees and answer questions.

3.2 PUBLIC COMMENTS RECEIVED

Both during PM #1 and afterwards, before the comment period end date of October 25, 2024, eighteen (18) public comment forms were received, which are included in **Attachment C**. In general, the comments received demonstrated broad support for added I-294 access to and from the south in the vicinity of the existing IL Route 19 interchange, with some noted issues/concerns related to ped/bike accommodations, traffic impacts, and property impacts. A few comment forms included questions or requests that will be separately responded to in writing.



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

Study Process


The Phase I Engineering study will follow Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) requirements to ensure compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act). The Study will evaluate a range of alternatives and recommend a preferred improvement plan that best supports the project goals including cost effectiveness, constructability, as well as avoiding, minimizing or mitigating environmental impacts. Key evaluation criteria for comparison of alternatives considered will include, but is not limited to transportation performance, environmental impacts, inclusion and/or compatibility with nonmotorized and transit improvements, compatibility with other planned transportation improvements, and public and agency support.

The Phase I Engineering Study is expected to be completed in 2026. After completion of the Phase I Engineering Study, subsequent phases of engineering and construction will be considered by the Tollway and IDOT contingent upon funding availability and project readiness.

Previous Feasibility Study


The Phase I Engineering Study will be based on a previous Feasibility Study completed in March 2021. The Feasibility Study was based on 2020 traffic data. The Phase I Engineering Study will include an updated alternatives analysis based on 2050 traffic projections, more detailed environmental studies and coordination, and more extensive public involvement and agency coordination in accordance with NEPA requirements. The results of the previous Feasibility Study can be viewed at this Public Meeting and are also available for viewing on the project webpage listed below.

Public Participation Opportunities

The Illinois Tollway and IDOT are completing Phase I Engineering based on the principles of **Context Sensitive Solutions (CSS)**. CSS is a collaborative approach that engages project stakeholders to identify relevant project issues and concerns, considers potential solutions that are compatible with the surrounding community (i.e., context), and that meet the established purpose and need for the proposed transportation improvement project.



The stakeholder coordination process is described in the Stakeholder Involvement Plan (SIP) prepared for the Study that can be viewed at this meeting and is also available on the project webpage. Coordination meetings will occur throughout the Phase I Engineering Study process with applicable jurisdictional and/or oversight agencies, including the FHWA, the Chicago Department of Aviation, various environmental resource agencies and other agencies as required. Other public participation opportunities include access to project information via the project webpage, public meetings, individual stakeholder meetings, and the established Community Advisory Group (CAG). Preliminary Project Problem Statement:

The purpose of this project is *“to solve motorized and non-motorized transportation problems in an equitable manner for existing and future conditions within the vicinity of the I-294 at IL Route 19 interchange.”*

Transportation problems to be solved include: Motorized and non-motorized safety, vehicular congestion and mobility during peak travel periods, operational deficiencies, non-motorized connections, improving access to side streets/businesses/homes, and reduce or eliminate barriers.

Additional key considerations for this project include: Maintaining the existing community character/context, minimizing adjacent property impacts, support local economy and development plans, and preserving the natural environment.






SAFETY TIER DATA

IDOT Safety Tier data categorizes roadway segments and intersections based on their level of safety performance and opportunity for improvement, providing a rating for relative comparison.

The Safety Tiers include Critical, High, Medium, Low or Minimal designation based on a review of crash severity and occurrences for comparable roadway types with similar roadway features and potential crash trends.




2050 No-Build Daily Traffic Projections





EXISTING INTERSECTION PERFORMANCE

2050 No-Build Intersection Performance






PREVIOUS FEASIBILITY STUDY

The Feasibility Study included:


- Preliminary Technical Analysis of 2020 Traffic Data, Environmental Database Information, Potential Alternatives




