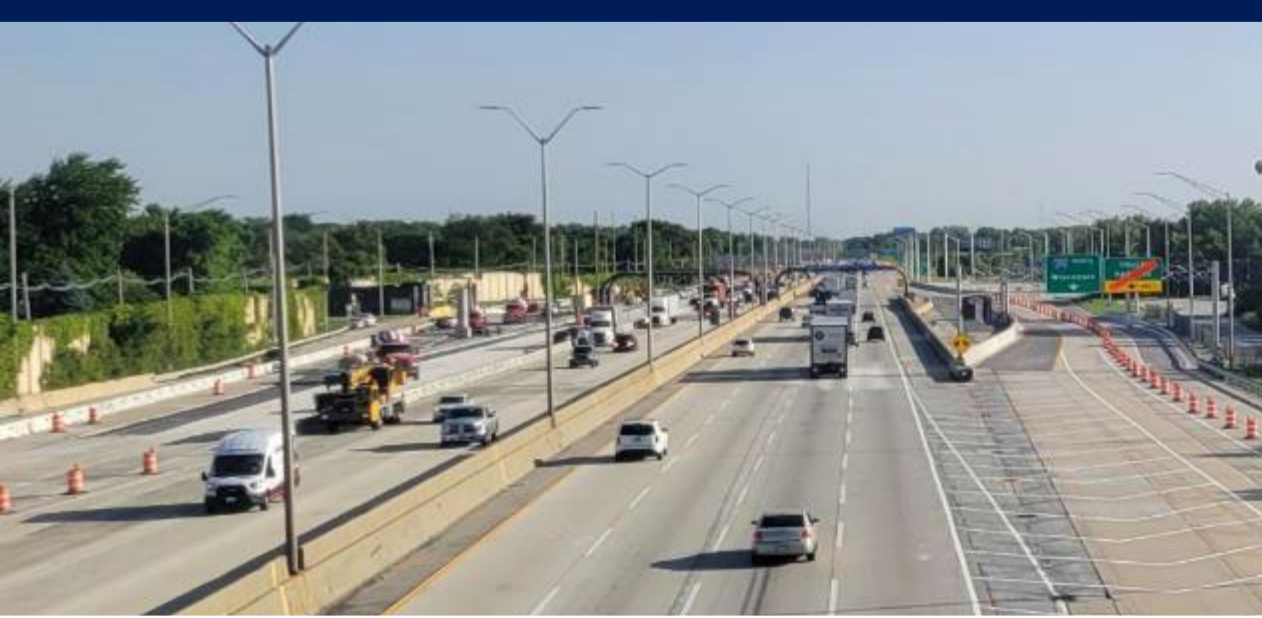




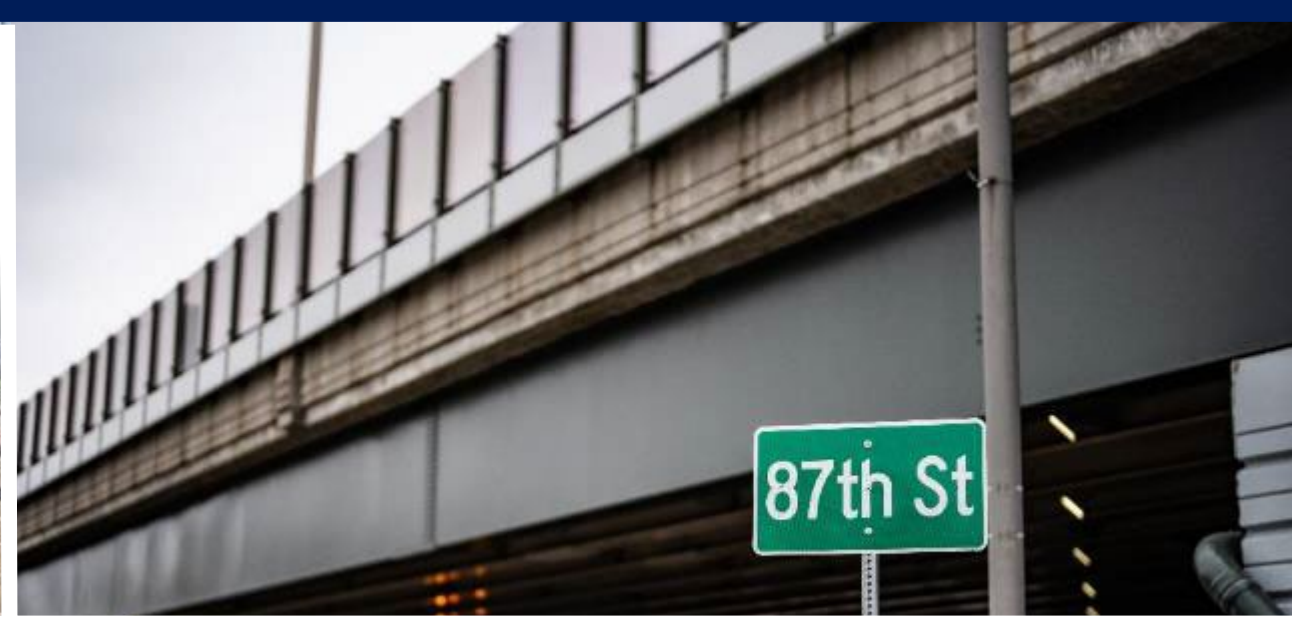

ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY PROJECT **UPDATE**

Innovations for Transportation Infrastructure Act (630 ILCS 10)
Signed into law June 15, 2022

Authorizes IDOT and Illinois Tollway to use the following project delivery methods

- Design-Build
- Progressive Design-Build
- Construction Manager/General Contractor

*“It is the intent of this Act to use design professionals, construction companies, and workers from this State, **reflecting the diversity of the State's businesses and workforce, to the greatest extent possible**”*

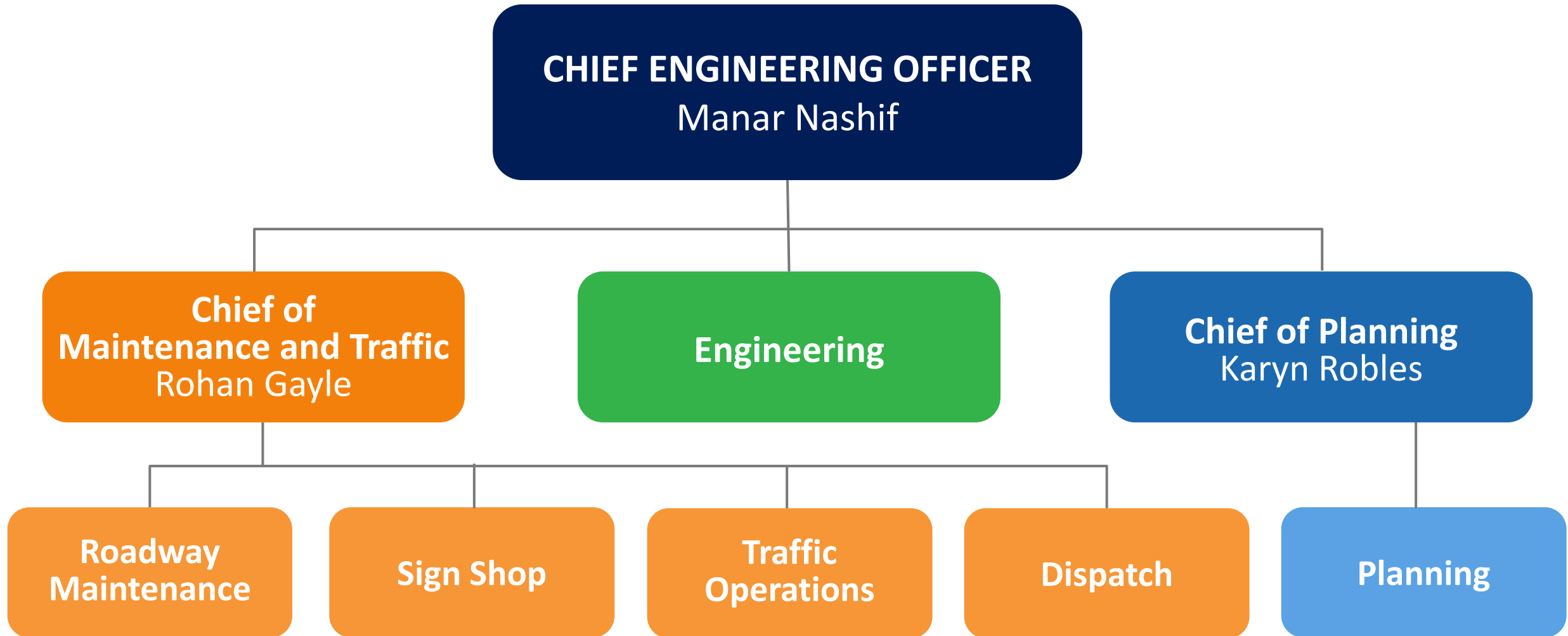
